Hauntology of Nation: Between the Stage and the State in Kashmir

This paper discusses the way in which political events since 1989 have dis-articulated the nation from the state in Kashmir. I argue that the Kashmiri nation oscillates between the live nation on the one hand and the death-dealing state on the other to produce a manifestly haunted nation, situated between two nuclear nation-states, India and Pakistan.
